

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION FOR THE KILIFI-UGANDA OPEN ON 20TH APRIL 2024

Eligibility: The competition is for amateur players.

Handicap Limit: Handicap Index is not more than 30.0 at the date of entry for men and women.

Entries: must be submitted by **Tuesday 16th April at 1700**.

Enter with the Vipingo Ridge Pro Shop.

Maximum entries are 40 per team and a total of 80 players in the Tournament

If the competition is oversubscribed then the entries will be accepted in the order received.

The Draw will be on Wednesday 17th April at 1500.

The Draw will be sent to Vipingo Members, Coast Captains, the KGU Captains, and the Uganda Manager.

The Vipingo Ridge website will have the Draw on the **What's On - Events**, under **Kilifi-Uganda Open**.

Entry fee: Kshs 1000 for Vipingo Ridge Members.

Kshs 3000 for non-members at the Coast Clubs.

Kshs 4500 for non-members at the wider Kenyan players.

(Ugandans have an inclusive fee).

Entry fee must be paid by mpesa before an entry can be accepted. If you have paid through the Stay & Play Package please share your payment receipt.

Format: 95% Stableford. 1 round of 18 holes.

Tees: Men play off the Whites, Course 2. Women off the Reds, Course 4.

Both 1st and 10th tees will be used for Starting.

First tee time 0800.

4 players in each Match.

Prizes: Winning Team Trophy, the Best individual, the Runner Up, the Third place.

The Best 1st 9 and Best 2nd 9.

Prize winners must be at the Prize Giving or they forfeit their prize to the next best player.





Scoring: The Kilifi-Uganda Open Trophy will be won by the team which has the most Stableford points.

If there are unequal team members then the total scores will be divided by the number of players on the teams (and the decimal point will be rounded up from 5) to find the team average score. The highest team average wins the trophy.

If both teams have the same score then the Open is tied and the result is declared drawn.

EXTRAS

Arrival: Be at the start tee 5 minutes early. The Rules of Golf apply.

Starting penalties: An early or late start within 5 minutes is a 2 stroke penalty, and more than 5 minutes is Disqualification (the player may continue to play but with no score).

Recording: Scorecards must be correctly signed and handed in to the Pro Shop scorer within 10 minutes of finishing.

The non-members and Ugandan players are to include their CDH and Handicap Index.

Local Rules: Published on the scorecard.

Additional: sanded and weeded areas: take Ground Under Repair relief Rule 16.1 The penalty areas marked with red stakes along the fairways are in force. The reference point of entry on the rivers on the 9th and 18th is where the natural boundary slopes down to the water.

The Drop Zone option is available on the 6th and 17th.
